



ST PAUL'S BARNES SWIMMING CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2011

Promoter's Conditions

The competition will be held at St Paul's School, Lonsdale Rd, Barnes, SW13 9JT on 2 weekends 17th&18th and 24th&25th September 2011. The 1500 Freestyle will be held at St Paul's Girls School, Brook Green, Hammersmith, W6 7BS on Wednesday 28th September 2011.

RULES OF ENTRY

1. All competitors must be members of St Paul's Barnes Swimming Club
2. The meet shall be run under ASA Laws and FINA Technical Rules of Swimming
3. In accordance with ASA Child Protection Policy, all photographic equipment including mobile phones and cameras must be registered at each session
4. The minimum age for each event in the Championships will be:
 - 50m and 200m – no minimum age
 - 100 IM and 200 IM – no minimum age
 - 100m – 10 years and over
 - 400m Free – 9 years and over
 - 400 IM - 10 years and over
 - 800m Free - 10 and over
 - 1500m Free - 11 and over
5. The distance events 800m and 1500m Freestyle will be swum as mixed events, boys and girls together, seeded in heats according to their entry times
6. Age is as at 28 September 2011
7. Entry times, which are not essential, will be short course times for the event distance
8. Meet Procedure:
 - The Championships will be pre-seeded and all swimmers will be pre-entered
 - All heats will be published 48hrs prior to the start of the first race



- A withdrawal system will be in operation. Swimmers not able to compete will have to withdraw by emailing the organisers 7 days prior to their race
 - All heats will be spearheaded
 - A swimmer who is late will lose the right to swim but may be placed in an unoccupied lane at the discretion of the promoter.
 - A list of heat and lane assignments will be posted. It is the swimmer's responsibility to check the heat sheet and be at the whipping area on time
 - Five minutes prior to the start of each session or one event prior to the one in which you are competing, you should present yourself to the whips
9. A medal will be presented to competitors finishing first, second or third in any event. Each swimmer will receive one medal only. The colour of the medal (Gold for first, Silver for second or Bronze for third) will be determined by each swimmer's highest position gained in any event

TROPHIES

10. FINA points system will be used.
11. Trophies will be presented in each age group:
- Age groups are: 8&under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16&over
 - Age Group Awards will be made to the Top male and female swimmer in each age group
 - The Age Group Winners for girls 13 and under and boys 14 and under will be determined by taking the aggregate of the highest score in each BAG Category relevant for their age group
 - The Age Group Winners in each of the girls 14 and over and boys 15 and over age groups will be determined by taking the aggregate of FINA points obtained in their best three events (to include two different strokes and two different distances)
 - The 200m winner in each age group 9 and over will be determined by taking the aggregate of the points scored in all 200m events, including the Individual Medley
 - The 200m winner of the 8&under age group will be determined by taking the sum of the points scored from their best three 200m events
 - Points for 200m trophy will be awarded on the basis of 6 for first, 5 for second down to 1 for sixth. No points will be awarded in the event of a disqualification
12. Challenge Cup for Junior 12&Under and Senior 13&Over in male and female category will be awarded to swimmers with the highest combined score of FINA points in these events: 200 Fly, 400 IM and 800 or 1500 Free
13. Record Breaker will be presented prior to the start of the championships to a swimmer with the most club records held at the end of the previous swimming season
14. If any of the above rules are subsequently found to have been contravened, the Promoter shall decide what action, if any, shall be taken against those concerned
